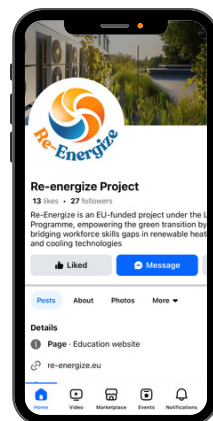
SKILLS4HP Cluster Webinar: Heat Pump Skills in Action
